Regional Qualifiers:

Top two division winners and the next four highest power ranked teams.

Final announcements will be made Monday, October 23. All regional qualifiers are required to attend and forfeiting regional tournament games will result in a one-year suspension from the league. Clubs must also confirm arrival time and lodging accommodations with Laurel Hanna (laurel-hanna@uiowa.edu) by Tuesday, October 24 by 5:00pm.

Tournament Format, Rules, & Eligibility:

Pool play on Saturday with the winner of each pool advancing to the semi-final round on Sunday. The home team is listed first on the schedule and shall wear light jerseys.

Club rosters must be submitted to the tournament table prior to the clubs first game. **All players must check in with their university issued student ID.**

NIRSA Bids:

NIRSA guarantees Region III three bids to the Championship Division of the NIRSA National Tournament. These bids will be handed out to the W-MASC Regional Tournament Champion and the top two highest power ranked teams at the conclusion of the regional tournament. In the event that the same team who receives the NIRSA automatic power ranking bid also wins the W-MASC Regional Tournament, then the power ranking automatic bid will go the third highest power ranked team. Additional bids, recommended at the discretion of the league commissioner and regional coordinator, will be based on overall performance during the regular season and regional tournament.

Awards:

The three automatic bid recipients from Region III will receive and \$1200 award towards their national tournament entry. Clubs will be reimbursed during the NIRSA National Tournament or after. At large bids may be eligible for a partial award as funding is available.
