Tournament Structure

- 12 Qualifying Teams in 4 Pools
- Day 1 – Round Robin Pool Play; Pool winners advance to elimination round
- Day 2 – Elimination Round with Semi-Final and Championship Games

Facility Requirements

- Two lined and well maintained regulation soccer fields with lights
 - Playing Surface:
 - Synthetic Turf – Preferred
 - Natural Grass
 - Field Dimensions
 - 180' – 225' x 300' – 360'
 - Adequate safety space of 15' – 30' around the exterior of each field
 - Regulation Goals & Nets:
 - Four goals (two per field), 8' high x 24' wide
 - Goal post not to exceed 5" width
 - Goals netted and free of rips/tears, etc.
 - Field Lining:
 - Freshly painted field markings
 - Corner Flags:
 - Eight corner flags (four per field)

- Exclusive use of facilities starting at **7:00 am Saturday, October 28, 2017 through 6:00 pm Sunday, October 29, 2017.** During this period the facility shall be clean and accessible with playing conditions and surrounding grounds safe and of championship caliber.
- Ability to offer permanent or temporary seating for teams and spectators
- Access to parking and restrooms proximal to the playing fields
- Electrical access at the game fields
- Space for an officials hospitality area with two tables and eight chairs proximal to the playing fields
- Space for the tournament desk with two tables and four chairs at the playing fields
- One table and two chairs at the playing fields for the Athletic Trainer

Other Preferences

- One table and two chairs at each field for tournament volunteers/staff
- Water cooler at each field monitored by the host site staff
- Facility staff and support personnel provided by host site
- Posting location for game schedule and results
- Certified Athletic Trainer or EMT on-site during event times
- Public address sound system for championship game
